- Foreseen Innovation laboratories and Teacher training centres in local HEIs should be established during the first year of the project implementation period.
- Highly recommended to prepare all needed legislative documents of foreseen centres as soon as possible.
- For the last year some of the involved universities in Uzbekistan have been granted an autonomy which should be considered as an asset for this task.
- Foreseen equipment should be purchased in the first half of the project's implementation





- Upload at least all basic information about the project and news in local languages as well.
- Provide contact details of all local HEIs and responsible team members.
- Very limited information is provided about the project on the official websites of the partner HEIs. The official HEIs` websites and project accounts in social networks should be considered as one of the main dissemination tools of the project.





- Finalise Quality and Dissemination Plan of the project.
- Within the Dissemination plan it would be feasible to envisage cooperation with the NEO in all promotion and information activities, including NEO information tools, annual publication and social networks. The NEO guidelines for local coordinators on organisation of project events should be considered.





- Foreseen establishment of 'Society of Mechatronics' should be carefully considered by the local project team in order to ensure timely registration by relevant national authorities
- and launching the society in the planned period.
- Minutes of local meetings should be regularly issued by project teams
- Considering the project objective "Introducing an ECTS accredited- EU-Uzbekistan co-created curriculum in Mechatronics", involvement 6 technical HEIs of Uzbekistan and MHSSE it would be feasible to envisage an information seminar (webinar) with the support of NEO.


