

WP3: DEVELOPMENT

Title	Development of the new training courses and organizing trainings for UZB teachers, staff and engineers		
Description	Intensive Training courses for Uzbek teachers will be carried out in different ways. Uzbek teachers will attend advanced Mechatronics trainings and seminars,		
	which are regularly conducted at European partner HEIs. They will also follow and observe undergraduate and postgraduate courses conducted at EU partner		
	institutions and take part in active teaching processes to be acquainted with the expertise of their European peers and practice learned teaching methodologies.		
	Upon establishment of mechatronics laboratories, training centres and development of new curriculum and teaching program, EU partners/teachers will arrive		
	in Uzbekistan and provide hands on training to Uzbek teachers on the new courses and laboratory equipment and sent guest lectures to respective Uzbek HEIs.		
Tasks	- Developing courses for trainers and lecturers for the acquisition of teaching and learning methods.		
	- Training and skills improvement for Uzbek teachers. Teachers from involved Uzbek HEIs will attend advanced Mechatronics trainings and seminars conducted		
	regularly at partner HEIs in EU – 2 trainers from all partner HEIs in Uzbekistan have to be trained at HEIs in EU.		
	- Organizing courses for lecturers for teaching and learning methods – 8 teachers from all HEIs in Uzbekistan have to be trained in Uzbekistan.
