1: Finalization of the curricula (TSTU).

Representative person of the TSTU, prof. M.Abdullayev introduced the modernized curricula and explained the all items. Modernized and developed curricula had been approved and accredited in Uzbekistan. Following options and items were explained and discussed:

- Analysis of curricula;
- Introduced 4 versions of curricula: AndMI version, TUIT version, TTPU version and TSTU-FPI-KEE- version, explained TSTU-FPI-KEE- version in detail;
- Courses, types, and descriptions;
- Other issues.

Feedbacks: Prof. Vytautas: not to change the chains of the courses, share the final version of the curricula to all partners (Javlonbek), all EU partners have to make the feedback for shared curricula.
